YEAR 11 STUDY LEAVE

Study leave for Year 11 students will start on **Friday 23rd May 2014**.

We are required to monitor and record the attendance of our Year 11 students until the last Friday in June. Up until the 23rd May students' attendance will be marked as normal. After that date, students will only be required to attend school if they have an examination. Students who attend school due to an examination, or they have chosen to undertake their revision in the school library; will be marked as present for that session (morning or afternoon). Students who are not in school will be marked as S (Study Leave). This counts against the schools absence figure as an authorised absence.
