Charity Bungee Jump, July 19th 2016

Dear Parents,

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in taking part in a bungee jump event, in school on July 19th. UK Bungee, who have been in operation for 25 years, are coming to Calday to give staff, students, parents and friends of the school the opportunity to do a jump.

Many people taking part in the jump are using this as an opportunity to raise money for their chosen charity, some are just taking the opportunity to challenge themselves to jump! Attached is a sponsorship form if you need one, or alternatively you may choose to set up a JustGiving page. After the bungee jump we would like to know how much you raised and which charity you raised it for so that we can gauge the impact that this event has had.

The cost of the jump is £60, which can be covered by the charity funds that you raise, provided that you make this clear to your sponsors in advance. The jump is looking to be very popular and there are a fixed number of places to be filled. This means that tickets need to be paid for on Scopay and it will be on a first come, first served basis. Anyone jumping must have paid and given in the relevant forms at least two weeks before the event. Any profit from the event will go directly to the school charity, the Refilwe Community Project.

A timetable will be drawn up for the day, each student having a half hour window to jump. Parents are welcome to come to watch and record their son/daughter do the jump. Students must be 14 or over on the day of the jump.

All the insurance and legal documentation is taken care of by UK Bungee. Calday is not responsible for the jump. In signing this form and paying for the jump, you are giving your son permission to take part and be put into the care of UK Bungee. The necessary waiver forms to be signed before the jump are attached.

Extra Information:

- The jump will be on the school field from a 160ft crane, over an airbag.
- Every jumper gets a certificate
- There will be t-shirts available to buy on the day for £15
- UK Bungee state that if a jumper is recording their own jump, only Go-Pro cameras and the official Go-Pro straps can be used.
- Jumpers have to be aged 14 and older on the day of the jump
- Anyone aged 50 or over needs a certificate from their doctor.
- Wear comfortable, casual clothes and no boots but trainers or securely fastened shoes.
- Glasses and hard contact lenses must not be worn but soft contact lenses can.
- More information can be obtained from ukbungee.co.uk.
- On the day of the jump, we will have a list of who has paid and given in permission forms. Jumpers on the list will need to have a stamp on their hand before they can jump and at their allotted time, they will sign the UK Bungee documentation before they jump.
- Certain medical conditions will exclude you from jumping, see the attached form.
- The Waiver form includes a question about how much you raised for your charity, this can be filled in on the day of the jump.

What you need to do now:

- Pay £60 on the online Scopay system for the jump
- All students jumping, regardless of age, must return the school permission form signed by a parent
- Any student who is **under the age of 16** on the day of the jump must fill in two waiver forms and send them back to school. Fill in and sign a Non-Standard Waiver and the Waiver form that parents sign as well.
- All jumpers **aged 16 and over** must fill in and sign the Waiver form and return it too school. The parental signature is not required on the Waiver form if the jumper is 16 or over.
- In summary, students aged under 16 hand in three signed forms, students 16 and over hand in two and parents who are jumping hand in one, the Waiver.

Definitions: 'Operator' in this Waiver means and refers to the UK Bungee Club.

(i) **do hereby acknowledge that:**

- (a) bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding are dangerous activities and that it involves the risk to me/my child

Full Name (please print) of death or bodily injury;

- (b) of my own free will and desire, I wish to participate/I am prepared to allow my said child to participate, in the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding and to do so at my own risk, and I accept full responsibility of any injury resulting there from, whether giving rise to a cause of action falling within the scope of paragraph (ii) (a) or (b) hereof or not, whether suffered by myself or my said child and whether fatal or otherwise. Without in any way limiting or detracting from the scope of the foregoing, injuries includes damage of any kind to the back, neck spinal column, brain, blood vessels (including the blood vessels serving or related to the eyes), eyes, nerves (including ocular nerves), central nervous system, cardio vascular system and also includes shock **AND** includes the event of a miscarriage suffered by any female as a result of participating in bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding.

(ii) **agree to indemnify and otherwise hold harmless**, the Operator, its officers, its committee, and person or business or company employed or authorised by the club for the carrying on of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding or any ancillary activity, from all and any caused of action, **whether** for damages, compensation or any other orders whatsoever, **whether** at common law, in equity, under statute or otherwise howsoever caused by my negligence or failure to follow proper instructions;

- (a) in and about the conduct of the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding including any activity or any procedure preceding or following the execution of a jump whether or not those activities or procedures are part of the preparation for or the recovery from a jump;

- (b) in and about the conduct of activities associated with or supplementary to or ancillary to the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding whether such activities are carried on by the Operator or some other person and whether such activities involve the offering for sale to the public or any section or group of the public or to any individual whatsoever of meals and/or refreshments and/or entertainment and/or activity of any kind whatsoever including the offering for sale of any goods or services whatsoever.

AND WHETHER such causes of action would be available to me in my own right or be available to be brought by me on behalf of or for the benefit of another or be available to be brought by me on behalf of myself and of another.

(iii) **do hereby acknowledge and warrant that:**

- (a) I am not aware of any present or past medical and/or physical condition which might endanger myself/my child or others whilst participating in the activity of bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding. In particular, but without anyway cutting down the scope of the preceding sentence:

- (i) I am not/my said child is not pregnant;
- (ii) I am not/my said child is not suffering from any ailment or defective condition of the heart, the lungs, the central nervous system, the vascular system, the muscles of the neck, back, legs or those connected with the eyes or of the eyes;

- (b) no medical practitioner has advised me/my said child against participating in bungee jumping, catapulting and cage riding.

(iv) Nothing in this Waiver shall exclude the liability of the Operator for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence of that of its officers, committee, employees or agents.

In consideration of the Operator allowing me/my child to proceed with bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding I hereby release the Operator and any person, firm or corporation engaged by it from all and any rights or entitlement that I/my child may otherwise have to any permanent or transient, moving or still, video or audio record leading up to my bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding through to the time after the completion of my bungee jumping, abseiling, powerfanning™, zip wiring, catapulting and cage riding being used for any purpose that the Operator may consider appropriate.

I have been fully informed and understand that, in comparison to the standard method of jumping or riding in the man-cage, there are greater/higher risks associated with the NON-STANDARD type, style or method of jumping off name-cage ridge that I have chosen to attempt, participate or carry out, WHICH MAY RESULT IN INJURY OR INJURIES.

I am fully aware that the risks involved with regards to non-standard jumps include:

- (a) a greater risk of entanglement with the bungee cord, and/or contact on collision with the bungee cord end attachments (i.e. hardware components), and/or other equipment.
 - (b) A higher risk of procedure/system, and/or equipment failure.
 - (c) A greater risk of aggravating any present or past medical and/or physical condition.
 - (d) A higher risk or operator error.
- With regards to non-standard rides in the man-cage:
- (a) A more uncomfortable ride in the man-cage.
 - (b) A higher risk of falling out of the man-cage.

(iii) do hereby acknowledge that:

this non-standard waiver form is to be used in addition to, and in conjunction with, the initial standard waiver form which I have already read and signed. The initial standard waiver form acknowledges, amongst other things, that I:

agree to indemnity and otherwise hold harmless, the Operator, its directors, offices, servants or agents from all and any cause of action, whether damages, compensation or any other orders whatsoever, whether at common law, in equity, under statute or otherwise howsoever and whether arising from negligence and/or breach of contract and/or breach on the part of the Operator, its directors, officers, servants or agents in and about the conduct or the activity of bungee jumping.

HEALTH WARNING NOTICE

IF IN DOUBT - DON'T JUMP

If you are not in good health you should **NOT** jump.

If you have any of the following conditions you should seek medical advice before jumping.

1. High Blood Pressure
2. Heart Condition
3. Suffer from Dizziness or Epilepsy
4. Damage to neck, back, spinal column, legs or eyes
5. Asthma
6. Pregnancy
7. Alcohol – If you appear intoxicated you cannot jump
8. Medication - please inform us if you are taking any form of medication.

**If you suffer from any of the above but have been given a doctors certificate,
You will be requested to sign a non standard waiver.**

- No under 14's
- 14 and 15 year olds require a parent or guardians permission and signature
- Over 50's are required to have a doctors certificate to comply with our insurance regulations
- Glasses and hard contact lenses cannot be worn
- If wearing boots please be prepared to remove them
- Maximum weight limit for a solo jumper is 120kg (18.9 stone)
- Waist harnesses fit waist size of 40cm (15.7 inches) to 125cm (49.2 inches)
